

Dear Parents/Carers,

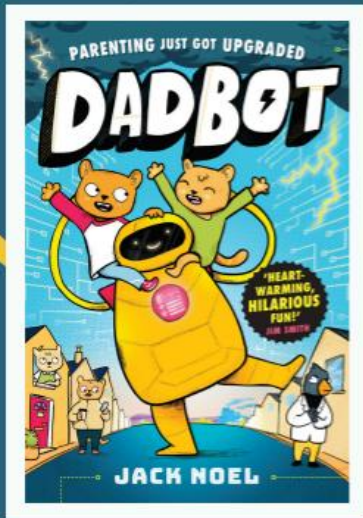
Lent Concert 2026
