

Our Week



We have had another busy but lovely week in

Reception this week. Here are some of the things we have done. Your child might like to tell you about them

- This week we have been reading the story 'The Tiny Seed' by Eric Carle. It helped us
 with learning about the different seasons and weather.
- This week focused on the weather wind, rain and sun. We blew bubbles to see the wind carry them, compared the amount of rainwater our different containers collected and drew around our shadows in the sunshine.
- We learnt about how seeds grow.
- In RE we discussed how an Angel spoke to the Shepherds and told them the Good news about the birth of Jesus. We continued to add to our Nativity scenes in our books
- In Maths our learning focused on the composition of 4, 5. We enjoyed making them using different Numicon shapes (for example 1 and 4 make 5). We developed our understanding of number by looking at part-part whole models.
- In Phonics we continued to blend and recapped sounds we found challenging. We also used our Fred fingers to spell three letter words. We have a learnt some "Red words" (tricky words) "I", "the" and "go"
- We are continuing to practise our Nativity songs during our Music lessons
- In Funky Fingers we continued to practise our fine motor skills by tracing numbers,
 using our cutting skills to cut along the lines and using playdough.
