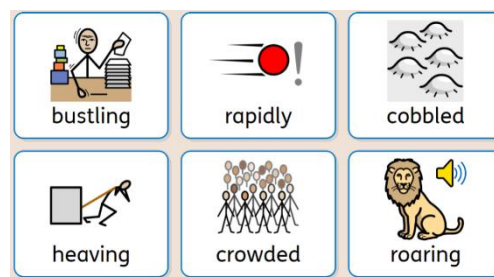

An art exhibition and prize giving ceremony will be held at Aldro school on 16th May 2025 for the children and family of prize winners.

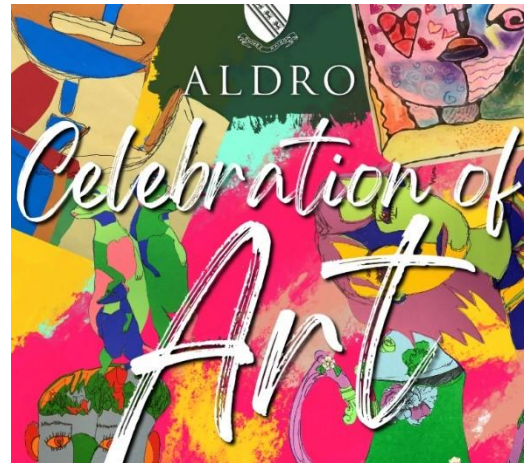
