Here are some of the things that we have been learning this week, your child might like to tell you a little bit more about them:

- We shared the story 'The Way Back Home' and wrote speech bubbles for the characters
- We wrote simple sentences about the pictures in the story. We are working on using finger spaces and full stops
- In RE we are continuing to learn about the church. We learnt how the early church was formed.
- We practised our pencil control each morning with number formation activities.
- In Maths we looked at the number 15 and practised our number recognition and formation of numbers throughout the week. We also learnt to make numbers to 20 with different resources.
- We learnt the words 'said, your and you' . Here are some songs you might like to practise at home to help your children with different tricky words.
