As a school we constantly review our resources and at the moment are reviewing how Mathletics works for us. Your child will come home with their login details and we ask that they login and complete the homework set for this week and not any Mathletics.

To login visit www.maths.co.uk

1. Click on the Login button (top right of the page)
2. Sign in using the username and password on the piece of paper your child has e.g.
Username: student557 Password: water550

To complete a quiz:

1. Click on the 'Begin Test' link
2. Click Next to move forward in the quiz
3. Click Finish once the quiz has been completed

If your child has any difficulty logging on please let one of us know as they will not need to attend homework club.

2. **Times Table Rock Stars:** please continue to do this AT LEAST once a week, preferably 5 minutes a day, practicing the times table that will be tested on Friday. Children will progress after getting full marks on their tables tests on three separate occasions.
3. **Mathletics:** None – please trial Maths.co.uk
4. **Spellings:** There are no spellings to learn for next week as it is the last week of term.

Times table quizzes will now take place on Thursday each week. Please ensure your child has their Times Table book in class ready for their quiz each week. Spelling quizzes will still be on a Friday.
