Write each word using a pencil. Then trace around the outline with a coloured pencil or pen.



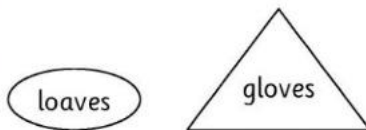
Three times
