It has been a week filled with Christmas celebrations and festive fun! Here are a few of the things we have done:

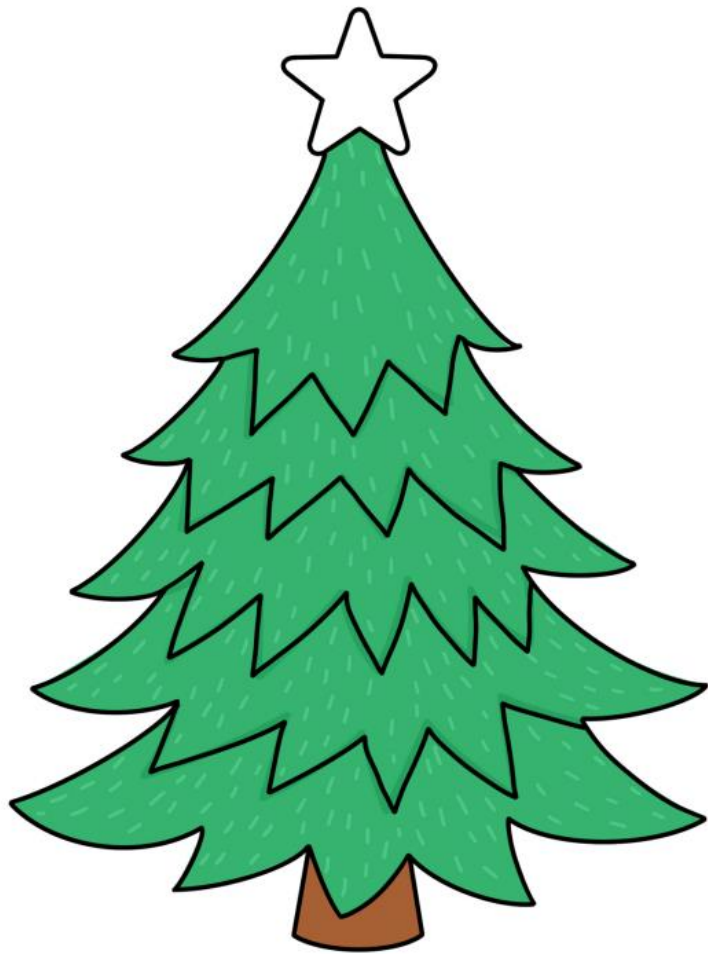
- Most importantly we performed our Nativity. We are so proud of the children; they have been working hard for weeks to practise and put on a wonderful show. They were fabulous!
