This week we have...

English - We read our adventure stories and made improvements before publishing it!

Maths - We have been learning about money, including coins and notes and counting money up. This is a great opportunity for you to do some extra maths at home 😊

Geography - We created our own sketch map of our local area by using an aerial photograph. Following this we made a key to show the different human and physical features on our map.
