- We found out about each other's Easter holidays by asking a partner questions. Some children brought in pictures of their holiday adventures to share with their class. We then wrote some lovely sentences about our News.
- We have been talking about our Families and we created our own "Family tree". It has been so lovely finding out about our extended families.
- We began our exciting new topic, Space, and received a visit from a very special alien in each class
- We wrote questions to ask the aliens where they might be from (and any other big questions we had for them!)
- We learnt about the solar system and what an astronaut's job is. Ask your child if they know why astronauts float in Space
- We read a variety of space focused books
- We did observational drawings of our alien visitor
- We started our new RE topic
- In Maths we focused on making numbers 11,12,13 and 14.
- During our PE lessons we had fun playing with the big bouncy balls.
- We carried on celebrating our differences during our PSHE lessons and talked about how all of our families are special and unique
- We have continued practising our letter and number formation each morning, trying to remember where to start and finish each letter and digit
- We have been enjoying our Read, Write, Inc. Phonics lessons this week and are so good at reading to our partners
