Friday 17th July – End of term 1:30pm home time. Please provide a strong bag for your child to take home their books.

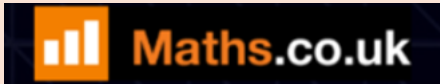
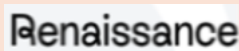
Ordering lunches– Thank you for ordering your child's lunch before they come to school. You can order in advance up until the end of term
