## What is the Phonics Screening Check?

 A national word-reading check at the end of Year 1.


Children read 40 words.

 This will be carried out during a week in June 2025.



#### What is the Phonics Screening Check?

The aim is to confirm whether individual children have learnt sufficient phonic decoding and blending skills to an appropriate standard set by the government.





#### What happens during the check?


- •The children will complete the check one at a time with their class teacher.
- •The check takes 5 to 10 minutes.
- •The test contains 40 words-

20 real words...



## What happens during the check?

- · ...and 20 pseudo (alien/nonsense)words.
- These will be new to all pupils.
- They do not favour children
   with a good vocabulary or good
   visual memory of words.





# What happens if my child does not pass?

- The Phonics Screening Check will be completed again in Year 2.
- Your child will continue to have extra practice and support in class.



#### How to help your child.

- 1. Practise reading sounds speedily.
- 2. Help your child to use 'Special Friends', 'Fred Talk' to read words.
- 3. Look out for the RWI Virtual Classroom links on the newsletter.
- 4. Listen to your child read their Storybook(s) every day.
- 5. Talk to us if you have questions or concerns.
