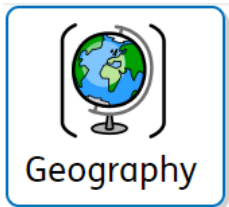

countryside	Land that is away from big towns and cities.	
village	A small town or community, often in the country.	
map	A picture of a place, drawn from above.	
distance	The measure of space between things, places, or points in time.
