Play - UPDATE

As you know, the children have been preparing for our end of year production, 'Gigglebox!'. They have been working so incredibly hard and we are really looking forward to the performance on Friday 10th July.

Currently, the weather is forecasted for very high temperatures. Whilst the weather may change (fingers crossed!) we are trying to plan ahead for the possibility that it may be too hot to perform on Friday 10th.

*We know that many of you need time to change your schedules and so just in case, we are scheduling a contingency date of **Wednesday 15th July at 9:30am** (please note this is not an extra performance but an alternative date to the current one).*

We hope that we won't need to change the date from our original 10th July slot to the 15th but want to be prepared. The children have put so much time and effort into this we want to ensure they can perform to you.

Lyrics – please ensure the children are learning the lyrics for the play. We have uploaded these to TEAMS and the backing tracks can be found online.

Costumes - We have spoken with the children about ideas for their costumes for the play. We are happy for you to decide the specifics at home. Please don't feel you have to purchase anything and contact us if you have any questions. Please ensure the children bring the costumes in by **Monday 6th July.**

Hoodies

The children are welcome to wear their leavers hoodies to school on Fridays.

Homework

POLY's LAST SPLASH - PARENT INFO

Please read the essential Parental Guidance and **respond on class WhatsApp by Sunday Jul 5th if you need to opt out or flag a dietary need.** (If not on WhatsApp, DM Charlotte Barden on 07720 549197).
No response = Your full permission and no dietary requirements.

Event Details:

- Mon Jul 13th, 5-7pm on St Polycarps School Field, drop-off & pick up from side blue gate.
- Bring labelled water guns – as big as they like! (a few squirters will be available for those without).

Activity Permissions:

- Attendance assumes permission to participate in all activities: **Foam, Holi Paint, Slip'n Slide, Water Guns**
- If you do NOT want your child included in these activities you must:
 - >> **Tell us** via the class WhatsApp poll so we can note it.
 - >> **Tell your child directly**, as it will be **their responsibility on the day to follow your wishes.**
- A dry fun zone will be available for anyone who prefers to stay splash-free.
- The event will be supervised and we'll do our best to keep the calmer zone as dry and mess-free as possible, but due to the nature of the party we cannot guarantee this or monitor individual activity choices.

Photo & Video Permissions:

- We cannot separate children into “photo/no-photo” groups during a live event. Therefore, **attendance is taken as approval for photos & videos.**
- Soon after the party, a link to a private portal will be sent out on the class WhatsApp group where you'll be able to view & download these for free, under the **strict agreement that no photos recordings, photos, or names will be uploaded to any social media platforms, personal or commercial websites.** This is to ensure the privacy and safety of all our children.

Clothing Advice:

- It will be wet - swimwear under party clothes or waterproofs recommended.
- It will be messy – clothes/shoes should be ones you don't mind getting colourful.
- Goggles will be useful eye protection for the water & Holi paint.
- Expect wet, foamy, colourful children – towels & warm layers advised for collection (for them and your car!)
- Make sure everything is labelled.

Food & Dietary needs:

- Nut-free snacks will be available: Hotdogs in bun (meat + vegan), donuts, cake, ice cream.
- Drinks: Mocktails, Bubbles Tea & water.
- If your child has dietary requirements or allergies, please complete the class WhatsApp poll ASAP.

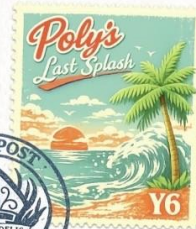

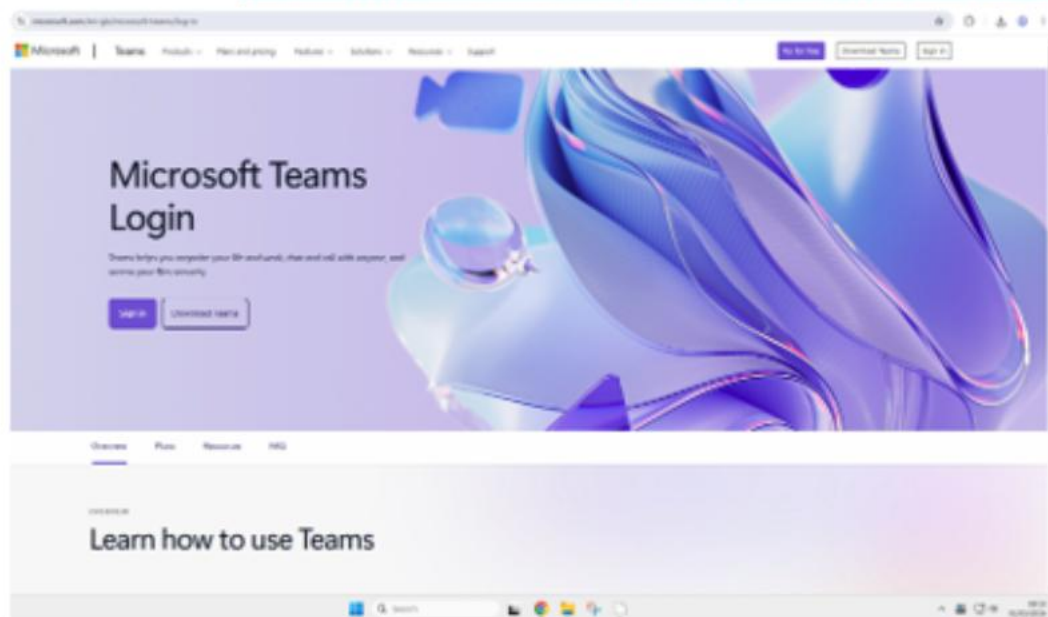

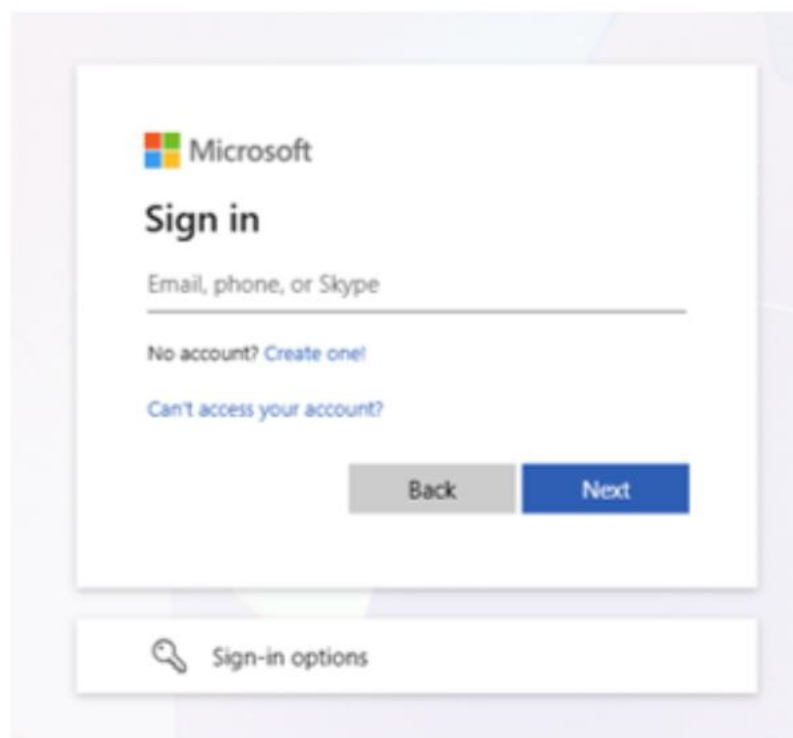
**Year 2 will also be hosting a Bake Sale to
