

Our Week



Below are some of the things we have done this week. Your child might like to tell you a little more about a few of these:

- We learnt the story of 'The Little Red Hen'
- We made masks from the story and enjoyed acting the story out on the stage.
- We used Pie Corbett actions to re-enact the story (here is a video to show Pie Corbett
 using the actions https://www.youtube.com/watch?v=JdvJZD-cplg
- We wrote speech bubbles for the characters in the story
- We baked bread (just like the little red hen). Learning how to knead bread was a super new skill!
- In R.E we learnt all about Baptism.
- In Phonics we learnt the letters and sounds for k,u,b and f
- Continued modelling reading a story
- Developed our understanding of number by looking at the number 4
- Compared objects by size, mass and capacity
- In Funky Fingers we practised our number formation, used 3 colours to copy and colour the little red hen, threaded shapes, made playdough cupcakes and used balance scales to weigh them, we cut out little red hen pictures to make puppets

Notes for parents

- Today your child will be coming home with their first reading book, how exciting!

 They will have these books for a week and be changed every Friday for now.

 Please read at least 3 pages of the book daily with your children. These books are used to help your children identify the sounds and with their blending.


