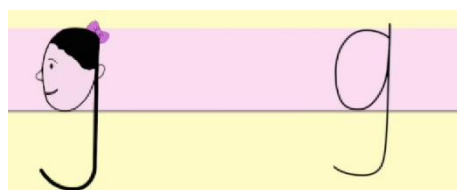
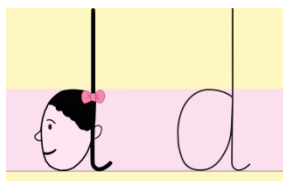
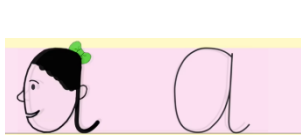
Tuesday 11th November- Parents’ Evening (*in person*)
