MATHS

3 SATs papers:

1x arithmetic paper (40 marks)

2x reasoning papers (35 marks each)

- Teacher assessed across the entire year (no SATs paper for writing).
- Regular conferencing – one on one feedback
- Writing inspired by book studies, other areas of the curriculum and events around the world.
- Range of genres
- Encouraged to edit and review writing with purple pens.
