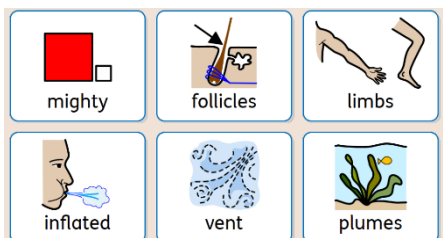
**Spellings on Edshed:** **patted, hummed, dropped, clapped, clipped, wrapped, napped, ripped, drummed, dragged.**
