Our Week in Year 1



Below are some of the things we have learnt this week. Your child might like to tell you a little more about a few of these:

Continued our teaching on subtraction in Maths, using a number line to help us.

Read the book 'The Wild Woods' and investigated question sentences. We also wrote our own questions in our book using the question words - What / Where / Who / When / Why / How.

Continued with our RE topic and looked at how Our Lady, Mary, is represented in different countries.

In Geography we went into the playground and used a simple map to find key features and fill in the words in the map key.

In Computing we explored 'digital painting' and used the website 'Paintz' to practise and made our own picture.

For Science we continued our topic on Seasonal Changes by choosing appropriate clothing for Autumn and talking about different events/activities that happen in Autumn.

In Art we produced our own artwork using printing with everyday objects.

Continued handwriting - correct letter formation and position on the line - see guidance below to help you support your child at home.

- Handwriting practice letters r, e and s. See guidance below.

<u>Has your child done any charity work recently?</u> As part of our learning, we teach children how they can follow in the footsteps of Jesus in the way they interact and help others. If your child has taken part in any charity work, please let us know so we can share and celebrate this in school.

<u>The Giving Tree</u> - This Christmas season, we will be taking part in **The Giving Tree** to support children living in refuge (https://kidsout.org.uk/the-giving-tree/). These children can receive very little - or in some cases nothing at all at Christmas. Families (and staff!) will have the opportunity to take a tag from the tree, purchase the gift listed for a child, and return it to school. We will then take the gifts to the local collection point where they'll be distributed to children living in refuge.

Each tag includes the name of a child and the gift they or their parents have said they'd love to receive.

How it works:

- Tags will be available to take **from Monday 24th November** from the tree by the office (exact location TBC).
- Families can take a tag, buy the gift, and return it **unwrapped** to school, these can be left under the tree.
- Deadline for returning gifts: **Wednesday 10th December**. This then gives us time to take them to the collection point to be wrapped and distributed to the children in time for Christmas.


