## Homework

### Times tables

Next week we will be carrying out our national multiplication check. Please make sure your child is practicing more than often for the coming days so they're feeling confident for next week. It runs the same as a soundcheck on Times table Rockstars, so run through these in anticipation of this:

- Complete two soundchecks per week on times table rockstars (mixed and timed times table test)
- Any additional timetable practise verbal/written would be amazing!
- Each week your child completes a times table check, they will take this home with them every Friday to show you. Please help your child with any gaps they have in their times table knowledge.

We understand that children retain facts at different rates and we do not expect them to remember them overnight!

### Maths

Maths homework will reflect the learning that is done in class during the week. It is set every Friday on Mathletics.

### Spellings

Weekly spellings will be uploaded to EdShed every Friday. The children will have one week to learn these. Children will be tested on Fridays.

### Reading in Key Stage 2

#### Reading

Children must continue to read for 15 minutes per day. They should use their reading records to write about their reading. At a minimum they should write the date and title of the book in their reading record. **The children must complete their reading quizzes online as part of their homework.**
