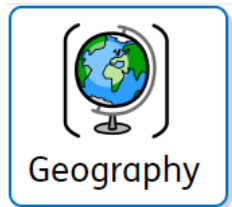

| Climate | Long term weather conditions in a specific region. | |
| Ice sheet | A layer of ice covering an area of land for a long period of time. | |
| Arid | Little or no rain. | |
| Savannah | Grassland with small or dispersed trees. | |
| Pack ice | A mass of ice floating in the sea. | |
| Equator | An imaginary line around the middle of the Earth, halfway between the North and South Poles. | |
| Desert | Arid area of land | |
| Tropical | A region that is warm. | |
| Temperate | A region with mild temperatures. | |
