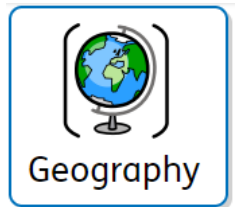

| Country | A land or nation with its own government. | |
| Continent | A large land mass. | |
