SPELLING, PUNCTUATION AND GRAMMAR

- SATs paper (20 marks for spelling, 50 marks for grammar)
- Varied approaches with time for application in writing
- Practice papers
- Rule-based learning (spelling rules vary each week)
- Spellings to be practised at home – set on Spelling Shed and tested Fridays

MATHS

3 SATs papers:

1x arithmetic paper (40 marks)

2x reasoning papers (35 marks each)

Some important topics:

- Addition, Subtraction, Multiplication, Division
- Fractions, Decimals and Percentages
- Ratio and Proportion
- Measurement- angles, perimeter, area etc
- Methods demonstrated on website
